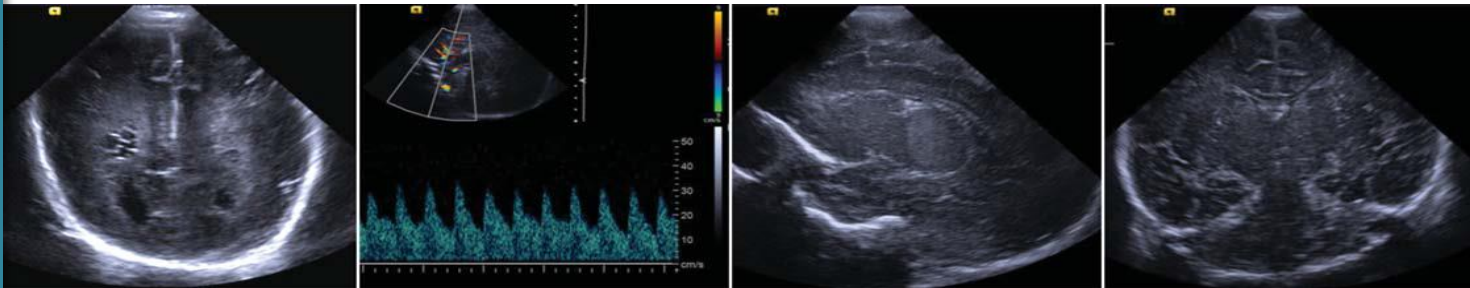


# Neonatal cranial ultrasound course: the essentials
